What We Pay

Writer fees depend on the difficulty of reporting and the amount of research required. In general, fees range from \$350 to \$500 per article, but can go higher if necessary. EWNS does not pay travel expenses.

What to Know About East-West News Service

- EWNS welcomes editorial contributions from established journalists who have studied the website and know our format.
- An initial suggestion should contain a link to the writer's webpage or several writing samples similar in style to the story being suggested. EWNS feature articles run from 1,200 words to a length appropriate for the narrative.
- Writers should take photos or provide duty-free images from travel and tourism offices.
- Keep seasonality in mind. That is, features appropriate for summer should be suggested by mid-spring so the story can be published by June.
- EWNS encourages the liberal use of hyperlinks in its travel features.
- Published articles include a brief author's bio at the end of the story along with hyperlinks to the author's past articles appearing on the website.
- All articles published by the East-West News Service are promoted globally with advertising on Facebook.
